




The Reading Problem

Reading and literacy are at critical lows across the nation. According to the 2024 NAEP

- 70% of 8th graders scored below proficient in reading
- 69% of 4th graders scored below proficient in reading
- 1 in 3 of 8th graders scored below basic in reading
- 2 in 5 of 4th graders scored below basic in reading
- Only one state recorded 4th grade reading growth (Louisiana)
